House Bill 3063

Sponsored by Representative RESCHKE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits local governments from adopting or enforcing ordinance, rule or regulation or taking actions that prohibit or limit local government or its subdivision, agency, department or office or employee from cooperating with or assisting federal immigration authority or carrying out immigration enforcement.

Repeals prohibition against public bodies and law enforcement from cooperating with or assisting federal immigration agency or immigration enforcement.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

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Relating to immigration; creating new provisions; repealing ORS 180.805, 180.810, 181A.820, 181A.823, 181A.826, 181A.827, 181A.828 and 181A.829; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

- (a) "Federal immigration authority" means the United States Department of Homeland Security, the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services, the United States Customs and Border Protection or a successor agency, any other federal immigration agency or official, or any other entity to which a federal immigration agency delegates or assigns the authority to detect, investigate or enforce violations of immigration law.
- (b) "Immigration enforcement" means any activity that has as a purpose the apprehension or identification of an individual in order to:
- (A) Subject the individual to civil immigration arrest, civil immigration detention, removal or deportation proceedings or removal or deportation from the United States; or
- (B) Criminally prosecute the individual for offenses related to federal laws regarding immigration status.
- (2) A unit of local government may not adopt or enforce any ordinance, rule or regulation or take any other actions that prohibit or limit the local government or a subdivision, agency, department or office or employee of the local government from cooperating with or otherwise assisting a federal immigration authority or carrying out any action that may be characterized as immigration enforcement.
- <u>SECTION 2.</u> ORS 180.805, 180.810, 181A.820, 181A.822, 181A.823, 181A.826, 181A.827, 181A.828 and 181A.829 are repealed.
- SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.

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
