

House Bill 3136

Sponsored by Representative LEVY B, Senator HANSELL; Representatives CATE, SCHARF, WRIGHT, Senator THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study issues related to telemedicine and to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care on or before September 15, 2024.

Relating to telemedicine.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study issues related to telemedicine. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
