

House Bill 3184

Sponsored by Representatives CRAMER, ELMER; Representatives MANNIX, MCINTIRE, Senator THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Removes suspension of requirement of showing proficiency in Essential Learning Skills as condition of earning diploma.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to high school graduation requirements; amending section 3, chapter 495, Oregon Laws
3 2021; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 3, chapter 495, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 3.** Notwithstanding any rules adopted by the State Board of Education, a student may not
7 be required to show proficiency in Essential Learning Skills as a condition of receiving a high
8 school diploma during the 2021-2022[,] **or** 2022-2023 [*or 2023-2024*] school year.

9 **SECTION 2.** **This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
