

House Bill 3265

Sponsored by Representatives HELFRICH, STOUT; Representatives MANNIX, WRIGHT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to conduct study of feasibility of reporting transactions electronically and each quarter, rather than each month.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reports to the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission shall conduct a study to**
5 **evaluate the feasibility and cost to the commission, and potential cost savings to persons and**
6 **entities that the commission regulates, of conducting all transaction reporting for liquor**
7 **sales electronically and on a quarterly, rather than monthly, basis. The commission shall**
8 **report the results of the study to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related**
9 **to alcoholic beverage control not later than September 30, 2024.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on December 31, 2024.**
