

House Bill 3312

Sponsored by Representative SANCHEZ (at the request of Oregon Recovers)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Revenue to study revenues received by state from transactions involving alcoholic beverages. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to revenue not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to revenues derived from sale of alcoholic beverages.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Revenue shall study revenues received by this state from**
5 **transactions involving alcoholic beverages. The department shall submit a report in the**
6 **manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the**
7 **interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue no later than September**
8 **15, 2024.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
