House Bill 3416

Sponsored by Representatives SMITH G, MARSH, OWENS, GOMBERG

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Business Development Department for distribution to recipients for industrial lands projects. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to industrial lands projects; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for

5 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$24,500,000 for

6 the department to distribute according to the following schedule to be used by each recipient

7 only for the respective industrial lands project there set forth:
