

House Bill 3520

Sponsored by Representative BREESE-IVERSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs agencies of state government to revoke remote work arrangements that were put in place due to COVID-19 pandemic.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to termination of remote work arrangements; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, shall revoke**
5 **remote work arrangements that were put in place due to the declaration of a state of**
6 **emergency issued by the Governor on March 8, 2020, or any extensions of the declaration of**
7 **emergency.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
