## House Bill 3556

Sponsored by Representative FAHEY, Senator HANSELL; Representatives BYNUM, GOMBERG

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to study issues related to abandoned recreational vehicles. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to transportation not later than September 15, 2024.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to abandoned recreational vehicles; and prescribing an effective date.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Transportation shall study issues related to abandoned

5 recreational vehicles. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS

6 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the

7 Legislative Assembly related to transportation no later than September 15, 2024.

8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.

9 SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023

10 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
