

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3563

By COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 16 through 26 and insert:

2 “(3) The Governor shall appoint the members of the advisory board. The members must be res-
3 idents of this state who reflect the geographic, racial, ethnic and gender diversity of this state and
4 who have necessary experience that will enable the advisory board to meaningfully advise the
5 commission on topics including, but not limited to:

6 “(a) Career-connected learning that provides learners with career awareness, exploration, prep-
7 aration and training in connection with professional and industry-based expectations;

8 “(b) Development of career pathways;

9 “(c) Youth education programs;

10 “(d) Workforce development programs;

11 “(e) Rural workforce needs; and

12 “(f) Workforce issues affecting underrepresented communities.

13 “(4) The advisory board must include representation from:

14 “(a) The forestry or wildfire sector;

15 “(b) The natural resources sector;

16 “(c) Workforce sectors that are experiencing workforce demands;

17 “(d) Communities in which the wildland-urban interface faces a high risk of wildfire exposure;

18 “(e) Underrepresented communities, including communities of color, rural communities and
19 communities that have faced generational poverty or other communities that have been historically
20 underrepresented in youth employment as determined by the commission by rule;

21 “(f) Tribal communities; and

22 “(g) Local workforce development boards.

23 “(5) Members of the advisory board serve for a term of four years at the pleasure of the Gov-
24 ernor.

25 “(6) Members may not receive compensation for service on the advisory board, but, subject to
26 any applicable laws regulating travel and other expenses of state officers and employees, may be
27 reimbursed for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of offi-
28 cial duties, as provided in ORS 292.495, with moneys available to the advisory board for the purpose
29 of reimbursing members.

30 “(7) The commission shall provide the advisory board with necessary staff support.”.

31 On page 4, line 29, after “state” insert “, nonprofit associations engaged in workforce develop-
32 ment”.
