

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5002

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
4 following purposes:

- 5 (1) **Administrative and support**
- 6 services \$ 3,595,824
- 7 (2) **Food safety** \$ 14,835,725
- 8 (3) **Natural resources** \$ 14,288,276
- 9 (4) **Market access** \$ 4,943,908

10 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
11 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
12 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-
13 cluding federal funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
14 described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for
15 the following purposes:

- 16 (1) **Administrative and support**
- 17 services \$ 12,555,244
- 18 (2) **Food safety** \$ 32,925,272
- 19 (3) **Natural resources** \$ 24,567,864
- 20 (4) **Market access** \$ 20,619,770

21 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
22 \$8,859,764 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
23 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
24 Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the Oregon Plan, to be used for activities
25 and projects to implement Article XV, section 4b, of the Oregon Constitution.

26 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
27 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
28 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act col-
29 lected or received by the State Department of Agriculture, for the following purposes:

- 30 (1) **Administrative and support**
- 31 services \$ 204,723
- 32 (2) **Food safety** \$ 2,431,874
- 33 (3) **Natural resources** \$ 8,756,079
- 34 (4) **Market access** \$ 8,277,735

35 “**SECTION 5.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
2 **July 1, 2023.”**

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
