

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5018

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Environmental Quality, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
4 following purposes:

- 5 (1) Air quality..... \$ 23,729,099
- 6 (2) Water quality..... \$ 41,029,519
- 7 (3) Land quality..... \$ 2,645,890
- 8 (4) Agency management..... \$ 1,754,702
- 9 (5) Debt service..... \$ 8,529,380

10 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
11 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
12 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the
13 proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from congestion mitigation
14 and air quality grants, drinking water protection, laboratory accreditation and woodstove
15 grants and for smoke monitoring laboratory services, but excluding lottery funds and federal
16 funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Department of Environ-
17 mental Quality, for the following purposes:

- 18 (1) Air quality..... \$113,325,766
- 19 (2) Water quality..... \$ 32,957,021
- 20 (3) Land quality..... \$ 99,073,155
- 21 (4) Agency management..... \$ 43,964,101

22 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
23 \$6,453,619 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
24 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources
25 Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to implement
26 Article XV, section 4 (8), of the Oregon Constitution.

27 “**SECTION 4.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the following expenditures by the
28 Department of Environmental Quality are not limited:

29 “(1) Expenditures for debt service and debt service administrative costs related to the
30 Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and the Pollution Control Fund; and

31 “(2) Expenditures made for loans from the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and
32 loans from the Pollution Control Fund.

33 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
34 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
35 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act, col-

1 lected or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:

2 (1) Air quality..... \$ 13,517,595

3 (2) Water quality..... \$ 18,729,195

4 (3) Land quality..... \$ 8,857,121

5 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
6 \$10,805,524 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
7 payment of expenses by the Department of Environmental Quality from American Rescue
8 Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Depart-
9 ment of Administrative Services and transferred to the Department of Environmental Qual-
10 ity, for the Onsite Septic Financial Aid Program.

11 “**SECTION 7.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
13 July 1, 2023.”

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
