SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to specified state agencies for certain purposes related to housing.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by specified state agencies for certain purposes related to housing.

Modifies certain General Fund appropriations for biennium ending June 30, 2023.

Declares emergency, effective [July 1, 2023] on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,**
6 **2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$7,386,826 for homelessness prevention services**
7 **delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and Eviction Prevention**
8 **Rapid Response programs.**

9 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
10 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July**
11 **1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$26,213,174 for homelessness prevention**
12 **services delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and Eviction Pre-**
13 **vention Rapid Response programs.**

14 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
15 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,**
16 **2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000 for the development and design of a**
17 **statewide, long-term rent assistance program for individuals who are rehoused with state**
18 **investments made by sections 4 and 5 of this 2023 Act.**

19 **SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
20 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,**
21 **2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,900,000 to increase shelter capacity and**
22 **connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-**
23 **tureally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities in desig-**

1 nated homelessness emergency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

2 **SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
3 ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
4 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$64,300,000 to increase shelter capacity and
5 connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-
6 turally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities in desig-
7 nated homelessness emergency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

8 **SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
9 ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
10 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 to provide support to members of
11 federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon experiencing homelessness.

12 **SECTION 7.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
13 ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30,
14 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,125,824 for the administration of
15 homelessness prevention programs and local plans addressing unsheltered homelessness in
16 designated homelessness emergency areas.

17 **SECTION 8.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
18 ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
19 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,145,303 for the administration of
20 homelessness prevention programs and local plans addressing unsheltered homelessness in
21 designated homelessness emergency areas.

22 **SECTION 9.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
23 ated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management, for the biennium ending June
24 30, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$923,925 for the coordination of efforts to
25 address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas as part of the activation
26 of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations Plan.

27 **SECTION 10.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
28 priated to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management, for the biennium beginning
29 July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$722,631 for the coordination of efforts
30 to address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas as part of the acti-
31 vation of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations Plan.

32 **SECTION 11.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
33 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
34 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$26,135,000 to increase shelter capacity and
35 connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide capacity support for cul-
36 turally responsive organizations and provide sanitation services for communities within the
37 OR-505 - Oregon Balance of State Continuum of Care.

38 **SECTION 12.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
39 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
40 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,250,000 for the administration of support
41 provided to address homelessness in communities within the OR-505 - Oregon Balance of
42 State Continuum of Care.

43 **SECTION 13.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
44 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
45 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 for deposit into the Emergency

1 Housing Account created under ORS 458.620, for the purpose of providing services and as-
2 sistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 who are homeless
3 or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families.

4 **SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
5 \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
6 payment of expenses by the Housing and Community Services Department from the Emer-
7 gency Housing Account created under ORS 458.620 for the purpose of providing services and
8 assistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 who are
9 homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families.

10 **SECTION 15.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
11 priated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July
12 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,854, for administration of the provision
13 of services and assistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12
14 who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or their families.

15 **SECTION 16.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
16 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out
17 of the General Fund, the amount of \$12,500,000 for the purpose of awarding grants to in-
18 crease access by youth experiencing homelessness to shelter facilities, outreach, culturally
19 specific services and mental health or substance abuse services and to strengthen partner-
20 ships with host home programs and other transitional housing options.

21 **SECTION 17.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
22 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out
23 of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,250,000 for the purpose of providing two-year grants
24 to organizations operating host home projects to establish, continue or expand operation of
25 host home projects for youth experiencing homelessness.

26 **SECTION 18.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
27 priated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out
28 of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,171,469, for the administration of programs and ser-
29 vices for youth experiencing homelessness.

30 **SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
31 made to the Housing and Community Services Department by section 229, chapter 669,
32 Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, for distributions to compensate
33 landlords for unpaid rent payments pursuant to sections 12 and 13, chapter 420, Oregon Laws
34 2021, is decreased by \$16,623,741.

35 **SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
36 made to the Housing and Community Services Department by section 1, chapter 556, Oregon
37 Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, is decreased by \$14,000,000.

38 **SECTION 21.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
39 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
40 on its passage.
