House Bill 5020

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds. Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to department for fire protection expenses.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Forestry Department; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium

beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following 6 purposes: 7

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.

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
