House Bill 5032

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Public Records Advocate.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Public Records Advocate; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$895,407

6 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of

7 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-

8 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Records Advocate.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
July 1, 2023.
