House Concurrent Resolution 10

Sponsored by Representative RUIZ (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Recognizes and honors John and Shirley Vandermosten for their leadership and service to people of Oregon.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 2 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten were raised in neighboring towns on the south shore 3 of Long Island, New York, and they met as students at Oceanside High School; and Whereas John Vandermosten served his country with honor and distinction in the United States 4 Navy; and 5 6 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten graduated from campuses in the State University of $\mathbf{7}$ New York system and became schoolteachers; and 8 Whereas in the early 1970s, John and Shirley Vandermosten moved to Oregon, seeing it as an 9 ideal place to live and raise their family; and Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten settled in Gresham, Oregon, where they have made 10 their home since 1972; and 11 12 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten quickly became leaders in their new community, and 13they have worked with passion and commitment to improve the quality of life in Gresham and East Multnomah County; and 14 Whereas after finding herself unable to communicate with the large Spanish-speaking population 15in her community, Shirley Vandermosten began taking Spanish lessons, which culminated in a B.A. 16 17 in Spanish from Portland State University and led to her work as a tutor at Mt. Hood Community College for 22 years; and 18 19 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten proudly serve on the board of East County Rising, and 20 they support its mission to engage, energize and elevate East Multnomah County by transforming 21governments to better reflect and represent the area's diverse and progressive community; and 22Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten regularly attend local political meetings and they "try to keep our finger on the East County pulse," in Shirley's words; and 2324 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten have been involved in numerous other civic, political 25and charitable organizations, giving tirelessly of their time; and Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten are leaders in the fight for human rights, justice and 2627inclusion for all; and 28 Whereas John and Shirley Vandermosten exemplify what it is to be community changemakers, and they care deeply about finding ways to improve the lives of individual people; and 2930 Whereas in a lifetime of dedicated work as educators, mentors and community activists, John and Shirley Vandermosten have touched countless lives and made their community a better place; 31
