

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 3 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 12, insert:

2 “**SECTION 9.** (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appro-
3 priation made to the Department of Revenue by section 1 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023
4 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the Personal Tax and
5 Compliance Division, is increased by \$259,658, for developing a schedule allowing personal
6 income taxpayers to voluntarily report self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

7 “(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
8 to the Department of Revenue by section 1 (6), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled
9 House Bill 5034), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the Information Technology
10 Services Division, is increased by \$164,842, for developing and maintaining data collection of
11 self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

12 “(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
13 to the Department of Revenue by section 1 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled
14 House Bill 5034), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for administration, is increased by
15 \$46,224, for the research and development of racial impact statements.

16 “**SECTION 10.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
17 expenditures established by section 2 (3), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill
18 5034), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
19 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements
20 from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described
21 in section 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected or received
22 by the Department of Revenue, for the Personal Tax and Compliance Division, is increased
23 by \$6,357, for developing a schedule allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report
24 self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

25 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
26 established by section 2 (7), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the
27 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
28 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from fed-
29 eral service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in sec-
30 tion 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected or received by the
31 Department of Revenue, for the Information Technology Services Division, is increased by
32 \$11,460, for developing and maintaining data collection of self-identified race and ethnicity
33 identifiers.

34 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
35 established by section 2 (1), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the

1 **biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
2 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from fed-**
3 **eral service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in sec-**
4 **tion 2, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected or received by the**
5 **Department of Revenue, for administration, is increased by \$10,392, for the research and**
6 **development of racial impact statements.”.**

7 In line 13, delete “9” and insert “11”.

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
