

# Senate Bill 121

Sponsored by Senator GORSEK (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits assignment of peace officer as school resource officer without school district's approval.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to school resource officers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Peace officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS 133.005.**

6 (b) **"School resource officer" means a peace officer who is assigned to a school.**

7 (2) **A school district may approve or disapprove an assignment of a peace officer as a**  
8 **school resource officer to a school within the school district.**

9 (3) **A peace officer may not be assigned as a school resource officer unless the school**  
10 **district approves the assignment.**
