## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Human Services to study options for protecting from disclosure in certain proceedings information regarding sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression of children in department's custody. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services not later than September 15, 2024.

Sunsets January 2, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to confidentiality of child welfare records.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study options for protecting from disclosure in juvenile dependency and termination of parental rights proceedings information regarding the sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression of children in the department's custody. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services no later than September 15, 2024.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
