## Senate Bill 267

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Early Learning and Care to conduct study on increasing availability of employment-related day care. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to early childhood not later than September 15, 2024.

Relating to employment-related day care.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Early Learning and Care shall conduct a study on increasing the availability of employment-related day care. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to early childhood no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
