SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Provides that student who legally entered United States as refugee, through special immigrant visa or under Compact of Free Association treaty between United States and Republic of Palau, Republic of the Marshall Islands or Federated States of Micronesia and who has not previously established residence in any state or territory of United States other than Oregon qualifies for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees at Oregon Health and Science University. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. ORS 353.123 is amended to read:

353.123. (1)(a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c) of this subsection, the Oregon 6 Health and Science University Board of Directors may exempt a student who is not a citizen or a 7 lawful permanent resident of the United States[, or who is a refugee, special immigrant visa holder 8 9 or COFA islander,] from paying nonresident tuition and fees for enrollment at Oregon Health and Science University consistent with policies adopted by the board or by university officials acting 10 11 under authority of the board.

(b) A student who is a COFA islander and who has not previously established residence 12 13 in any state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia other than Oregon shall qualify for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees for enrollment as an under-14 graduate student and as a graduate student in a degree program at Oregon Health and Sci-1516 ence University.

17 (c) A student who is a refugee or special immigrant visa holder and who has not previously established residence in any state or territory of the United States or the District of 18 Columbia other than Oregon shall qualify for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees 19 20 for enrollment as an undergraduate student and as a graduate student in a degree program 21at Oregon Health and Science University.

22(2) A student who is not a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States, or who 23is a refugee, special immigrant visa holder or COFA islander, is eligible to receive scholarships and other financial aid from the university consistent with policies adopted by the board or university 24 officials acting under the authority of the board. 25

(3) As used in this section, "COFA islander," "refugee" and "special immigrant visa holder" 26 27have the meanings given those terms in ORS 352.287.
