

Senate Bill 282

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Education for Senator Michael Dembrow)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Legislative Policy and Research Office to study issues related to child care providers obtaining insurance. Directs office to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to child care not later than September 15, 2024.
Sunsets January 2, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child care providers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Policy and Research Office shall conduct a study to:**

5 **(a) Identify existing barriers to obtaining insurance for child care providers; and**

6 **(b) Identify and recommend strategies for improving access to insurance for child care**
7 **providers.**

8 **(2) The office shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may in-**
9 **clude recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assem-**
10 **bly related to child care no later than September 15, 2024.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
