CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to attorneys; amending ORS 352.132; and repealing sections 2 and 3, chapter 675, Oregon Laws 2021.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 352.132 is amended to read:

352.132. (1) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall [report annually to the Attorney General on] annually make available on the university's website a report describing the university's use of outside counsel for legal matters. The report must include:

(a) The types of matters handled by outside counsel;

(b) The number of litigation matters handled by outside counsel; and

(c) The total amount spent on outside counsel, categorized by type of matter.

(2) Reports under this section may be altered to protect the privacy of students and university employees and to comply with the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. 1232g), the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, the attorney-client privilege, or other state and federal confidentiality rules.

SECTION 2. Sections 2 and 3, chapter 675, Oregon Laws 2021, are repealed.
