

# Senate Bill 403

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON, Representative EVANS (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows person who retires from Department of State Police as police officer to participate in group benefit plan offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board with no increase in premiums.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Public Employees' Benefit Board.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.105 to**  
5 **243.285.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

7 (a) "Normal retirement age" has the meaning given that term in ORS 238.005 or 238A.160,  
8 as applicable.

9 (b) "Police officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS 238.005.

10 (2) A person who is a retired member of the Public Employees Retirement System and  
11 who retired from the Department of State Police as a police officer on or after reaching  
12 normal retirement age shall be eligible to participate as a retired employee in one of the  
13 group benefit plans described in ORS 243.135. The premium amounts charged to a retired  
14 employee for coverage under this section may not exceed the premium amounts charged to  
15 the employee before the employee was retired.
