

Senate Bill 411

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON, Representative EVANS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Adds certain hospital, medical and infectious waste incinerators to facilities at which covered drugs under drug takeback program may be disposed of.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the disposal of covered drugs at incinerators subject to federal requirements; amending
3 ORS 459A.224.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 459A.224 is amended to read:

6 459A.224. Covered drugs must be disposed of:

7 (1) At a hazardous waste disposal facility that meets the requirements of 40 C.F.R. parts 264 and
8 265, as in effect on September 29, 2019; *[or]*

9 (2) At a municipal solid waste incinerator that is permitted to accept pharmaceutical waste[.];

10 **or**

11 **(3) At a hospital, medical and infectious waste incinerator:**

12 **(a) That is subject to and meets the requirements of:**

13 **(A) 40 C.F.R. part 62, subpart HHH, as in effect on the effective date of this 2023 Act; or**

14 **(B) 40 C.F.R. part 60, subpart Ec, as in effect on the effective date of this 2023 Act; or**

15 **(b) That is covered by a state or tribal plan for existing hospital, medical and infectious**
16 **waste incinerators approved by the federal Environmental Protection Agency.**
