

Senate Bill 419

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON, Representative RUIZ; Representative LEVY B (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Human Services for Hunger Task Force to support state's policy on hunger.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Hunger Task Force; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of**
6 **the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000, to increase the capacity and equitable impact of**
7 **the activities of the Hunger Task Force to support the state's policy on hunger.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
10 **on July 1, 2023.**
