On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "creating new provisions;" 1 2 In line 3, delete "amending ORS 336.059;". 3 Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert: "SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall conduct a study to determine how 4 to integrate instruction on the identification and prevention of sex trafficking into academic  $\mathbf{5}$ 6 content standards for students in kindergarten through grade 12. "(2) For the purpose of the study described in subsection (1) of this section, the depart-7 ment shall consult with law enforcement agencies, survivor advocacy organizations, traf-8 9 ficking prevention organizations and culturally specific organizations. 10 "(3) The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative 11 Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2024. 12

13 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.

"SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
July 1, 2023.".
