

# Senate Bill 479

Sponsored by Senator HANSELL (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules allowing donation of meat to charitable organizations and other organizations that offer food for noncommercial purposes.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

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Relating to the use of meat.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. The State Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules allowing donations to charitable organizations, including low-income nutritional centers, and to other organizations that offer food for noncommercial purposes, of meat that is:**

**(1) Processed by a person licensed by the department under ORS chapter 603 to slaughter meat animals and subject to federal meat inspection.**

**(2) Processed under a federally approved program of state inspection for the processing and sale of meat products from amenable species, as described in ORS 619.042.**

**(3) Processed at a custom processing establishment, or slaughtered at a custom slaughtering establishment, pursuant to ORS 619.010 to 619.026 and 619.036 to 619.066.**

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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
