

Senate Bill 490

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON; Representative REYNOLDS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Medical Board to support alliance program for family medicine residency training programs in this state.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to family medicine residency training programs; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 677.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Medical Board shall support an alliance program for family**
6 **medicine residency training programs that supports the existence and development of family**
7 **medicine residency training programs in this state by providing resources for family medi-**
8 **cine residency training program directors, faculty and residents.**

9 **(2) The support provided by the board under subsection (1) of this section may be used**
10 **by the alliance program for purposes including but not limited to promoting this state's**
11 **family medicine residency training programs, increasing training for residents in maternal**
12 **and reproductive health care and developing programming for family medicine residency**
13 **training program directors, faculty and residents.**

14 **SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Oregon Medical Board, for the biennium be-**
15 **ginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 for the purpose of**
16 **carrying out the provisions of section 2 of this 2023 Act.**

17 **SECTION 4. (1) Section 2 of this 2023 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2024.**

18 **(2) The Oregon Medical Board may take any action before the operative date specified in**
19 **subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after**
20 **the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and**
21 **powers conferred on the board by section 2 of this 2023 Act.**

22 **SECTION 5. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023**
23 **regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
