SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Forestry Department to study community-based programs for reducing wildfire risk. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to natural resources no later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to community-based programs for reducing wildfire risk.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The State Forestry Department shall study community-based programs for**
5 **reducing wildfire risk. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS**
6 **192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the**
7 **Legislative Assembly related to natural resources no later than September 15, 2024.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
