

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 531

1 Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 327.**

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Summer and After-School Learning and Enrichment Grant Program**  
4 **is established for the purpose of providing grants to:**

5 **“(a) School districts, education service districts and public charter schools for summer**  
6 **and after-school learning and enrichment programs for youth in kindergarten through grade**  
7 **12; and**

8 **“(b) A fiscal agent for distribution to federally recognized Indian tribes in this state,**  
9 **community-based organizations and other organizations providing expanded learning or**  
10 **enrichment opportunities for summer and after-school learning and enrichment programs**  
11 **for youth in kindergarten through grade 12.**

12 **“(2) The Department of Education shall administer the grant program established by this**  
13 **section by:**

14 **“(a) Proposing quality and oversight standards for summer and after-school learning and**  
15 **enrichment programs for adoption by rule by the State Board of Education. For the purpose**  
16 **of this paragraph, the department shall regularly consult with school districts, education**  
17 **service districts, public charter schools, federally recognized Indian tribes, community-based**  
18 **organizations and other organizations providing expanded learning or enrichment opportu-**  
19 **nities.**

20 **“(b) Implementing a process for awarding grants that:**

21 **“(A) Prioritizes funding for summer and after-school learning and enrichment programs**  
22 **that serve youth from rural areas or historically underserved populations, including youth**  
23 **with disabilities and foster youth.**

24 **“(B) Encourages and supports partnerships between school districts, education service**  
25 **districts, public charter schools, federally recognized Indian tribes, community-based organ-**  
26 **izations and other organizations that provide expanded learning or enrichment opportunities.**

27 **“(C) Aligns outcomes of existing programs, organizations or services provided to youth**  
28 **or for the benefit of youth.**

29 **“(D) Is open, transparent and inclusive and, when possible, addresses administrative**  
30 **barriers that limit or prevent community-based, culturally responsive summer and after-**  
31 **school learning and enrichment programs from accessing grant funding.**

32 **“(3) The State Board of Education may adopt any rules necessary for the administration**  
33 **of this section.**

34 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**  
35 **priated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the**

1 **General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, for the Summer and After-School Learning and**  
2 **Enrichment Grant Program established under section 2 of this 2023 Act.**

3 **“SECTION 4. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
4 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**  
5 **July 1, 2023.”**

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
