

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5504

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Corrections, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following
4 purposes:

- 5 (1) **Operations and health**
6 services \$ 1,453,194,979
- 7 (2) **Central administration**
8 **and administrative**
9 services \$ 219,342,756
- 10 (3) **Correctional services** \$ 86,249,733
- 11 (4) **Community corrections** \$ 277,406,303
- 12 (5) **Debt service** \$ 101,514,230
- 13 (6) **Capital improvements** \$ 3,186,299

14 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
15 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
16 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
17 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Cor-
18 rections, for the following purposes:

- 19 (1) **Operations and health**
20 services \$ 39,498,592
- 21 (2) **Central administration**
22 **and administrative**
23 services \$ 24,012,466
- 24 (3) **Correctional services** \$ 2,761,625
- 25 (4) **Community corrections** \$ 6,859,278

26 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
27 \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
28 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Cor-
29 rections.

30 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
31 \$16,874,296 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
32 payment of expenses by the Department of Corrections from American Rescue Plan Act
33 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
34 ministrative Services and transferred to the Department of Corrections.

35 “**SECTION 5.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
2 **July 1, 2023.”**
