

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5509

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
4 following purposes:

- 5 (1) Fish Division \$ 24,098,459
- 6 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 6,159,262
- 7 (3) Administrative Services
- 8 Division \$ 8,141,668
- 9 (4) Debt service \$ 2,496,250
- 10 (5) Capital improvement..... \$ 169,181
- 11 (6) State Police enforcement..... \$ 2,853,401
- 12 (7) Habitat Division \$ 20,237,193

13 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
14 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
15 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-
16 cluding federal funds from the Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund, but excluding lottery
17 funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the State De-
18 partment of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

- 19 (1) Fish Division \$ 87,587,702
- 20 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 43,415,588
- 21 (3) Administrative Services
- 22 Division \$ 55,750,447
- 23 (4) Capital improvement..... \$ 6,590,855
- 24 (5) Debt service \$ 1,833,610
- 25 (6) State Police enforcement..... \$ 31,373,062
- 26 (7) Habitat Division \$ 26,266,545

27 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
28 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
29 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to
30 the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for activities and projects to implement Article
31 XV, section 4 (8), of the Oregon Constitution, for the following purposes:

- 32 (1) Fish Division \$ 5,351,561
- 33 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 1,461,960
- 34 (3) Habitat Division \$ 4,846

35 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts

1 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
2 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act col-
3 lected or received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the following purposes:

- 4 (1) Fish Division \$122,463,324
- 5 (2) Wildlife Division..... \$ 50,416,713
- 6 (3) Administrative Services
7 Division \$ 8,863,221
- 8 (4) Capital improvement..... \$ 3,489,212
- 9 (5) Habitat Division \$ 28,270,217

10 “SECTION 5. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
12 July 1, 2023.”
