

A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5524

Ordered by the Senate June 9

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Business Development Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from specified fund for specified purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Authorizes certain nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department,**
6 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for**
7 **the following purposes:**

- 8 (1) **Arts..... \$ 4,376,546**
- 9 (2) **Debt service \$ 90,722,590**

10 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appro-**
11 **riated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July**
12 **1, 2023, out of the General Fund, for infrastructure, the following amounts for the following**
13 **purposes:**

- 14 (1) **Rivoli theater restoration..... \$ 750,000**
- 15 (2) **Port of Coos Bay navigation**
- 16 **channel..... \$ 10,000,000**
- 17 (3) **St. Helens waterfront**
- 18 **redevelopment..... \$ 684,000**
- 19 (4) **Municipal building departments**
- 20 **financial assistance grants \$ 1,000,000**
- 21 (5) **Sweet Home wastewater**
- 22 **treatment plan upgrade \$ 3,500,000**

4 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, for business, innovation and trade, the following amounts

9 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
10 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
11 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
12 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Devel-
13 opment Department, for the following purposes:

- 14 (1) **Operations.....** \$ 4,253,298
- 15 (2) **Business, innovation**
- 16 **and trade.....** \$245,344,891
- 17 (3) **Infrastructure.....** \$215,788,458
- 18 (4) **Arts.....** \$ 18,228,924

19 **SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
20 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
21 of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from American Rescue Plan
22 Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of
23 Administrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Business Development Department,
24 for the following purposes:

- 25 (1) **Operations.....** \$ 360,477
- 26 (2) **Business, innovation**
- 27 **and trade.....** \$ 408,641

28 **SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
29 \$267,642,183 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for
30 payment of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from American
31 Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon
32 Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Business Development
33 Department, for infrastructure, for grants approved in section 196, chapter 669, Oregon Laws
34 2021.

35 **SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
36 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
37 of expenses by the Oregon Business Development Department, from the Broadband Fund
38 established by section 4, chapter 17, Oregon Laws 2020, for the following purposes:

- 39 (1) **Operations.....** \$ 380,782
- 40 (2) **Infrastructure.....** \$106,619,218

41 **SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
42 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
43 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic De-
44 velopment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following pur-
45 poses:

- 1 (1) Operations..... \$ 15,436,848
- 2 (2) Business, innovation
- 3 and trade..... \$ 77,456,902
- 4 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 4,591,498
- 5 (4) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,479,463
- 6 (5) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 47,504,550

7 **SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
8 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment
9 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development
10 Department, for the following purposes:

- 11 (1) Operations..... \$ 633,078
- 12 (2) Business, innovation
- 13 and trade..... \$ 37,258,810
- 14 (3) Infrastructure..... \$ 57,803,364
- 15 (4) Arts..... \$ 2,208,982

16 **SECTION 10.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures by the Oregon Busi-
17 ness Development Department are not limited for:

- 18 (1) Loans from the following funds:
- 19 (a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-
20 opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small
21 Business Expansion Loan Fund (ORS 285B.133).
- 22 (b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine Nav-
23 igation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708), Safe
24 Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213), Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS
25 285A.188) and Oregon Brownfield Properties Revitalization Fund (ORS 285A.198).
- 26 (2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation
27 bonds.

28 **SECTION 11.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
29 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
30 July 1, 2023.

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
