9 "<u>SECTION 8.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 10 **\$1,994,469,796** is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit 11 for payment of expenses by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board from the Oregon Educators 12 Revolving Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

"SECTION 9. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect
July 1, 2023.".

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
