

# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5543

Ordered by the Senate March 15  
Including Senate Amendments dated March 15

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 1, chapter 658, Oregon Laws 2021, as amended by section 1, chapter 111,  
6 Oregon Laws 2022, is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 1.** The amounts authorized, as provided by ORS 286A.035, for issuance of general obligation  
8 bonds of the state during the 2021-2023 biennium are as follows:
