**SUMMARY**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the State Board of Pharmacy and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:**

**(1) Remote Dispensing Site Pharmacy: \$225**

**(2) Pharmacy Prescription Lockers: \$120**

**(3) Pharmacy Prescription Kiosk: \$120**

**SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.**
