

Senate Bill 600

Sponsored by Senator CAMPOS; Representative NELSON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission for distribution to Oregon Office for Community Dispute Resolution at University of Oregon. Prohibits commission from distributing moneys to Oregon Consensus program at Portland State University.

Appropriates moneys to commission for distribution to Clinical Legal Education Program.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
6 **2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,980,000, for distribution to the Oregon Office**
7 **for Community Dispute Resolution at the University of Oregon for the purpose of increasing**
8 **eviction and homelessness prevention services and restorative justice services. Moneys allo-**
9 **cated under this section may not be distributed to the Oregon Consensus program at**
10 **Portland State University.**

11 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
12 **ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
13 **2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$250,000, for distribution to the Clinical Legal**
14 **Education Program.**

15 **SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
17 **on July 1, 2023.**
