

Senate Bill 621

Sponsored by Senator LIEBER, Representative NOSSE (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority to allocate to community mental health programs for oversight of residential facilities and for conducting abuse investigations.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to community mental health programs; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$_____ , which shall be allocated to community mental health**
7 **programs for residential facility oversight activities under ORS 430.630 and for conducting**
8 **investigations of abuse in residential facilities under ORS 430.735 to 430.765.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
11 **July 1, 2023.**
