Senate Bill 629

Sponsored by Senator LIEBER, Representative NELSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies membership of Oregon State Hospital Advisory Board.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to Oregon State Hospital Advisory Board; amending ORS 179.560.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 179.560 is amended to read:
5	179.560. (1) There is established in the Oregon Health Authority the Oregon State Hospital Ad-
6	visory Board, consisting of 16 members. Two nonvoting members shall be from the Legislative As-
7	sembly, one appointed by the President of the Senate and one appointed by the Speaker of the House
8	of Representatives. Fourteen members shall be appointed by the Governor and be subject to confir-
9	mation by the Senate in the manner prescribed in ORS 171.562 and 171.565 and shall include the
10	following:
11	(a) [Three] Two voting members who are individuals who advocate for or provide representation
12	to individuals with mental illness;
13	(b) [Three] Two voting members who are health care professionals who have experience working
14	with individuals with mental illness;
15	(c) [Two] Three voting members who are or have been consumers of mental health services, at
16	least one of whom is a former patient of the Oregon State Hospital located in Salem, Marion County;
17	(d) [One] Two voting [member who] members each of whom is a member of [the] a family of
18	a consumer of mental health services;
19	(e) Two voting members who are members of the general public [who live in the vicinity of the
20	Oregon State Hospital located in Salem, Marion County]; and
21	(f) Three nonvoting members who are members of a public employee bargaining unit and who
22	are employed by the Oregon State Hospital located in Salem, Marion County, as follows:
23	(A) One individual to represent board-certified physicians;
24	(B) One individual to represent board-certified nursing staff; and
25	(C) One individual to represent direct care services staff.
26	(2) Members appointed by the Governor shall serve four-year terms, but a member serves at the
27	pleasure of the Governor. Before the expiration of the term of a member appointed by the Governor,
28	the Governor shall appoint a successor whose term begins on July 1 next following. A member is
29	eligible for reappointment.
30	(3) Members of the board appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House
31	of Representatives shall serve two-year terms.
32	(4) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appointment to

1 become immediately effective for the unexpired term.

2 (5) The Governor shall select one of the voting members of the Oregon State Hospital Advisory

3 Board as chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for such terms and with duties and powers

4 necessary for the performance of the functions of such offices as the Governor determines.

5 (6) A majority of the voting members of the board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of 6 business.

7 (7) The board shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a
8 majority of the members of the board.

9 (8) The Oregon Health Authority shall provide staff support to the board.

10 (9) A voting member of the board may not individually or in a fiduciary capacity have a finan-11 cial interest in the Oregon State Hospital located in Salem, Marion County.
