

Senate Bill 641

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that Oregon Health Authority and Department of Education may not adopt rules requiring immunization against COVID-19 as a condition of attendance in any school, children's facility or post-secondary institution of education.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 433.235 to**
5 **433.284.**

6 **SECTION 2. The Oregon Health Authority may not adopt rules requiring immunization**
7 **against COVID-19 as a condition of attendance in any school, children's facility or post-**
8 **secondary institution of education, as that term is defined in ORS 433.281.**

9 **SECTION 3. The Department of Education may not adopt rules requiring immunization**
10 **against COVID-19 as a condition of attendance in any school, children's facility or post-**
11 **secondary institution of education, as that term is defined in ORS 433.281.**
