## SENATE MINORITY REPORT AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 697

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "expungements" insert a period and delete the rest
2	of the line.
3	Delete lines 4 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 7 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study expungements of
5	arrests, charges, citations and convictions, including the qualifications and procedures for
6	expungements or the sealing or setting aside of records of arrests, charges, citations and
7	convictions in other states. The commission may, if necessary, hire outside counsel to assist
8	with the study.
9	"(2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended
10	legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related
11	to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than January 1, 2025.
12	"SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
13	priated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023,
14	out of the General Fund, the amount of \$150,000, for the purposes of carrying out the pro-
15	visions of section 1 of this 2023 Act.
16	"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.".
