

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 780

1 Delete lines 6 through 13 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful fender height modifications**
3 **if the person operates a motor vehicle on a highway and the motor vehicle has been modified**
4 **by any means so as to cause the height of the front fender to be four or more inches greater**
5 **than the height of the rear fender, as measured vertically from the ground through the**
6 **centerline of the wheel to the bottom of the fender.**

7 **“(2) The offense described in this section does not apply when a motor vehicle is carrying**
8 **a load that causes the height of the front fender to be four or more inches greater than the**
9 **height of the rear fender.**

10 **“(3) The offense described in this section, unlawful fender height modifications, is a Class**
11 **C traffic violation unless commission of the offense contributes to an accident. If commission**
12 **of the offense contributes to an accident, the offense is a Class A traffic violation.”.**
