

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 790

1 On page 14 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 35 through 45 and delete page 15 and
2 insert:

3 “**SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
4 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023
5 (Enrolled House Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for state assessments and
6 enterprise-wide costs, is increased by \$205,644 for two positions in the Office of Training,
7 Investigations and Safety.

8 “**SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
9 expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill
10 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses
11 from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and Medicare re-
12 cepts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental
13 Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery
14 funds and federal funds not described in section 2 (8), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (En-
15 rolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department of Human Services for
16 shared services is increased by \$339,279 for two positions in the Office of Training, Investi-
17 gations and Safety.

18 “**SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, and the limitation
19 on expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House
20 Bill 5026), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
21 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and Medicare
22 receipts and including federal funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental
23 Security Income recoveries and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery
24 funds and federal funds not described in section 2 (2), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2023 (En-
25 rolled House Bill 5026), collected or received by the Department of Human Services for state
26 assessments and enterprise-wide costs is increased by \$2,615 for two positions in the Office
27 of Training, Investigations and Safety.

28 “**SECTION 12.** Section 8 of this 2023 Act is repealed on June 30, 2028.

29 “**SECTION 13.** (1) Section 2 of this 2023 Act and the amendments to ORS 419B.005 by
30 sections 3 and 4 of this 2023 Act apply to incidents occurring on or after July 1, 2023.

31 “(2) The amendments to ORS 419B.005 by sections 5 and 6 of this 2023 Act apply to inci-
32 dents occurring on or after July 1, 2028.

33 “(3) The quarterly report described in the amendments to ORS 419B.019 by section 7 of
34 this 2023 Act is first due on January 1, 2024.

35 “**SECTION 14.** The amendments to ORS 419B.005 by sections 5 and 6 of this 2023 Act be-

1 **come operative on July 1, 2028.**

2 **“SECTION 15. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
3 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
4 **on its passage.”**

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
