

# Senate Bill 834

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits local governments from prohibiting or limiting residential use of energy sources. Provides for certain exceptions.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to use of energy sources.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A unit of local government may not adopt or enforce any ordinance, rule**  
5 **or regulation or take any other actions that prohibit or limit the residential use of an energy**  
6 **source.**

7 **(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section shall limit the authority of a local govern-**  
8 **ment to adopt or enforce a local ordinance, rule or regulation or take other actions strictly**  
9 **necessary to comply with:**

10 **(a) The Uniform Building Code published by the International Conference of Building**  
11 **Officials, as amended and adopted by the Director of the Department of Consumer and**  
12 **Business Services;**

13 **(b) A uniform fire code; or**

14 **(c) Any requirement of a state or federal statute or regulation.**
