

# Senate Bill 901

Sponsored by Senator GELSER BLOUIN

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Confers authority to Director of Human Services to issue investigative subpoenas for production of specified records in child abuse investigations.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to investigative subpoenas in child abuse investigations; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In connection with an investigation under ORS 419B.020, the Director of**  
5 **Human Services may by subpoena compel the production of documents and records, including**  
6 **audio records, video records, photographs and student records, that the director deems rel-**  
7 **evant or material to the investigation.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**  
10 **on its passage.**
