

Senate Bill 923

Sponsored by Senator GELSER BLOUIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to designate person's school or program of enrollment. Prohibits designation of nonstandard school or program that does not meet specified requirements.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to school enrollment designation of student; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Nonstandard school or program" means a school or program of a school district that**
6 **serves all residents of the school district and for which enrollment is not based on attend-**
7 **ance boundaries.**

8 (b) **"Standard school" means a school of a school district that serves the residents of the**
9 **school district based on attendance boundaries.**

10 (2) **When a school district admits a person under ORS 339.115, the school district shall**
11 **designate the school or program of enrollment for the person.**

12 (3) **A nonstandard school or program may not be the designated school or program of**
13 **enrollment if:**

14 (a) **The rights and responsibilities that accrue to a person under ORS chapters 329 and**
15 **343 when the person is enrolled in a standard school do not accrue to a person enrolled in**
16 **the nonstandard school or program; or**

17 (b) **The effectiveness of the nonstandard school or program is not assessed as provided**
18 **by ORS 329.085, the nonstandard school or program does not conduct a self-evaluation under**
19 **ORS 329.095 or the Superintendent of Public Instruction does not produce a performance**
20 **report for the nonstandard school or program as provided by ORS 329.105.**

21 (4) **If a person is enrolled in a nonstandard school or program that is not eligible to be**
22 **the designated school or program of enrollment, as provided by subsection (3) of this section,**
23 **the school district shall designate a standard school in which the person is enrolled.**

24 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act first applies to the 2023-2024 school year.**

25 **SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
27 **July 1, 2023.**
