PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3154

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Legislative Revenue Officer and the Legislative Policy and Research Director shall jointly study revenue sharing
models for distribution of Oregon State Lottery revenues to Indian
tribes in Oregon that operate casinos.

6 "(2) As part of the study, the Legislative Revenue Officer shall:

7 "(a) Research historical revenues from the Oregon State Lottery;

8 "(b) Research potential revenue increases from new legalized gam9 bling in Oregon; and

10 "(c) Develop potential revenue sharing models.

"(3) As part of the study, the Legislative Policy and Research Di rector shall:

"(a) Research fiscal policies adopted in other states relating to
 gambling revenues; and

"(b) Research policies adopted in other states relating to gambling
 regulation.

"(4) The director, in collaboration with the Legislative Revenue Officer, shall prepare a report describing the results of the study, which may include recommendations for legislation. The director shall submit the report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to gambling regulation no later than September 15, 1 **2024.**

2 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,
3 2025.".
