PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 631

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) A public employee who is employed by any of the following public employers may refuse to work one scheduled mandatory overtime shift in any given week in which the public employer has scheduled the public employee to work one or more mandatory overtime shifts without the risk of discipline, retaliation or any adverse employment action and without the loss of pay or accrued leave:

- 8 "(a) The Department of Corrections;
- 9 "(b) The Oregon State Hospital; and

"(c) The Stabilization and Crisis Unit of the Department of Human
 Services, Office of Developmental Disabilities.

"(2) A public employer listed in subsection (1) of this section may
 not:

"(a) Discipline, retaliate or take any adverse employment action
 against the employee for refusing to work one scheduled mandatory
 overtime shift in any week in which the public employer schedules the
 employee to work one or more mandatory overtime shifts; or

"(b) Require the employee to take leave without pay or to use paid
personal time off, sick leave, vacation leave or any other accrued paid
time off or leave to make up for the refusal to work the shift.".
