**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2048**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 22 through 25 and insert:

2 “(a) Must be issued to the applicant if the applicant meets the criteria for  
3 registration under subsection (1) of this section;

4 “(b) Must be issued within five business days of the date on which the  
5 office received the completed application for registration under subsection  
6 (1) of this section if, within the five-day period, the office has not issued to  
7 the applicant a registration under subsection (1) of this section; and

8 “(c) Expires on the date on which registration under subsection (1) of this  
9 section is issued to the applicant or, if the applicant is denied registration,  
10 on the date on which the registration is denied.”.

11 In line 29, delete “January 1, 2024” and insert “October 1, 2023”.

12 On page 2, after line 4, insert:

13 **“SECTION 4. The Health Licensing Office shall contract with a  
14 third party to study access to behavior analysis interventionists in this  
15 state. The office shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS  
16 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the in-  
17 terim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care  
18 no later than September 15, 2024.**

19 **“SECTION 5. Section 4 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,  
20 2025.”.**

21 In line 5, delete “4” and insert “6”.
