**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2656**

1 Delete lines 5 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) Each school district shall make available to the**
3 **students of the school district the following informational surveys:**

4 **“(a) A survey administered by the Department of Education that is**
5 **designed to assist the department in gathering information about the**
6 **education experiences of students in this state, including information**
7 **on learning, opportunities to learn and school culture and climate; and**

8 **“(b) A survey administered by the Oregon Health Authority in col-**
9 **laboration with the department that is designed to improve the health**
10 **and well-being of all students in this state and to help them succeed.**

11 **“(2)(a) At least five days prior to the administration of a survey**
12 **identified in subsection (1) of this section, the school district must**
13 **provide:**

14 **“(A) Notice of the survey to the parents or guardians of the stu-**
15 **dents to whom the survey will be administered; and**

16 **“(B) The opportunity for parents or guardians to review the survey**
17 **before it is administered.**

18 **“(b) Parents or guardians must be allowed to decline, either**
19 **verbally or in writing, to have their children participate in a survey**
20 **identified in subsection (1) of this section.**

21 **“(3) Students may decline, at any time and either verbally or in**

1 **writing, to participate in a survey identified in subsection (1) of this**
2 **section.**

3 **“(4) Students who participate in a survey identified in subsection**
4 **(1) of this section may decline to answer individual questions on the**
5 **survey.**

6 **“(5) The department shall annually review the surveys identified in**
7 **subsection (1) of this section and make any revisions in the collection**
8 **of data and the distribution of data to enable school districts to assist**
9 **schools in providing an environment that encourages healthy and**
10 **successful learners.”.**

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
